In June 2006, Eureka umbrella E!3790 EurekaBuild on "Technologies for a sustainable and competitive construction sector" was approved in the NPCs meeting in Prague. This initiative was promoted by the European Construction Technology Platform (ECTP) in collaboration with the National Construction Technology Platforms (NTPs) from 18 countries, with the following aims:

- To mobilise the sector in each country, through the NTPs, in order to prepare Eureka projects, fitting with the research priorities that have been defined in the Strategic Research Agendas.
- To promote contacts with Public National Administrations to get support for Eureka projects.

EurekaBuild is managed by a Steering Committee with NUP and NUS representatives from the 18 countries. A small Technical Committee is dealing with the daily activities, with six members: ASM, University of Zagreb, BAM, Sintef, CSTB and Dragados.

This umbrella is promoting project ideas through:

- The dedicated area of ECTP website (www.ectp.org)
- Thematic workshops: four were planned for the first half of 2007, in The Netherlands on Networks, in Norway on ICT, in Greece on Cultural Heritage and in Czech Republic on Advanced materials.

At the Steering Committee meeting in Athens, in May 22, we will revise the strategy to assure future development of Eureka projects.

I would like to invite those countries that are not in EurekaBuild to join this initiative because, together, we have to develop the planned research priorities using all instruments, at European, Multinational and National levels.



Rotterdam, 22-23 January 2007

Deltaneth - Dutch Construction Technology Platform

The first EurekaBuild brokerage event was held on January 22rd and 23rd in Rotterdam and successful indeed. In total 75 people from 11 countries were attending this event. The brokerage event was organised by the Dutch Construction Technical Platform called Deltaneth and the theme was "Towards a reliable and available public infrastructure". Several keynote lectures were held to specify the needs for innovation in this field and to stimulate interaction with market parties who presented there innovations by posters and short oral presentations.



Also the Dutch national contact point Sentemovem was invited to explain the Eureka structure and Dutch procedure in a very practical way. At the end of the event about 40 innovations were collected. 
